In research, in vital statistics and in the words and experiences of so many Milwaukeeans, we see and hear the persistent and systemic racism that has inhibited our economic growth, harmed our public health and resulted in far too many people in our vibrant Black and Brown communities left out and left behind.

To address these disparities, we must reimagine the vital building blocks of a better life on a communitywide scale:

making major, lasting changes that advance educational opportunity, health equity, economic opportunity, and housing security for all Milwaukeeans, both now and in the years to come.

The transformative, systemic change we need is only possible if we work together with a new level of depth, scale, partnership and impact. That is why the Foundation is stepping forward to launch the Greater Together campaign today.

WHY THE FOUNDATION?

When we all work hand in hand, we can achieve an impact that's greater than any one of us could achieve on our own – and the Greater Milwaukee Foundation is how Milwaukee works together.

Transformational change on the issues that matter most only happens when we all work together: community leaders and activists, businesses and nonprofit organizations, elected officials and public agencies, and visionary philanthropists and volunteers like you.

And for more than a century, the Foundation has been at the heart of our community, working to bring people together to make the change we need. We were one of the first community foundations in the world, founded over a hundred years ago because

But our true strength is our deep network of community partners: landmark institutions and grassroots organizations, donors and advisers, civic leaders and voices for change throughout Milwaukee, Washington, Ozaukee and Waukesha counties.



We know that where a person lives impacts how a person lives, and that social determinants have been shown to influence a person's health more than genes, behavior and access to health care. That's why we launched the ThriveOn Collaboration: a new model to address interrelated health, economic, social and racial inequities together through a historic place-based investment.

This collaboration between the Greater Milwaukee Foundation, the Medical College of Wisconsin and Royal Capital attempts to catalyze change in the Halyard Park, Brewers Hill and Harambee neighborhoods through a range of programs and investments that draw from models in other cities while putting residents at the center of decision-making.

- Redeveloping the former Gimbels building on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
 Drive as a multifaceted community hub that will also be home to MCW's community engagement programs and the Foundation's headquarters
- Creating new community spaces designed with resident input, including an early childhood learning center, healthy food options and a business hub
- Complementing these investments in place with investments in related programs and the surrounding neighborhood, all focused on our key community outcomes and the social determinants of health: housing, early childhood education, food access, health and wellness, community engagement and economic opportunity.

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE & EDUCATION

A plan to transform early childhood care and education in our region.

Early childhood care and education is the key to giving every child the start in life they need and deserve: in the critical years between birth and 3 years, 80% of a child's brain is developed. And every investment in early childhood care and education is an investment in the potential in all of our region's children – and in the future of our entire region, with each \$1 invested providing a \$9 benefit.

Despite this, only 1 in 3 Milwaukee children have equitable access to early childhood education, and Black and Latino children are disproportionately affected. That's why we are rallying our community to make a generational investment in a regionwide strategy to create an accessible, affordable, high-quality early childhood care and education system for all.

- Expanding access to quality early childhood care and education in neighborhoods where it is most needed
- Increasing recruitment, retention and professionalization of the early childhood education workforce
- Partnering with Milwaukee Succeeds and the MKE Early Childhood Education Coalition – a group of dozens of local experts, practitioners and parents – to implement shared strategies toward these goals
- Establishing a new, high-quality early childhood care and education center for our neighbors in the ThriveOn King building

HOUSING

Bringing dignified, affordable housing within reach of all.

Everyone needs a dignified, affordable

home. Housing is a major building block of life, health and wealth: the foundation on which people can pursue and achieve their goals, build stronger, more stable communities and build generational wealth. When people can't afford safe, affordable housing, they are forced to make difficult choices that impact their health, their community connections, their children's educational opportunities and their financial lives.

And unfortunately, Milwaukee stands as the well-documented center of the national housing crisis, with too many people –

particularly in Black and Brown communities confronting decades of intentional and racist policies and practices – struggling with eviction, rising rents that transform an individual's financial reality and prices that make homeownership an increasingly unattainable ideal.

That's why the Greater Milwaukee Foundation is a founding member of the Community Development Alliance – a collection of funders, neighborhood-based organizations, community leaders and public officials – and why we are rallying our donors and stakeholders to join us in moving forward a unified housing strategy.

- Aligning and streamlining more than 20 existing housing programs so that city agencies, nonprofit service providers, funders and residents can work together with a shared vision and approach
- Increasing affordability for renters

- Preventing displacement as historically Black and Brown neighborhoods grow and develop
- Increasing homeownership for Black and Brown families

- Reinvesting financial returns generated into new projects that make a difference for our communities
